



Dear Elders and families:

On behalf of Sherbrooke, I want to thank you for all of your support and understanding throughout this challenging time, and I am happy to report Sherbrooke remains free of Covid-19 cases.

As of July 7th, the Saskatchewan Health Authority has released guidelines that support each long-term care home resident to designate two visitors for indoor visits based on the home's capacity to accommodate visitors and maintain their ability to follow the Public Health Orders.

Each Elder has the ability to designate two visitors. Families can return this contract (which is attached to this email) signed with two designated visitors specified and contact their neighbourhood manager by phone or by email.
